Preface


- ❑ Book of Mormon contains a historic record of ancient civilizations of America and tells of their origin

 - Little was known about these ancient civilizations at the time the Book of Mormon was published


Preface

- Salvation of mankind






- ❑ Broken Down Church

Second Vision

Chichen-Itza

- Of Chichen-Itza, a city of twelve square miles, F.A. Mitchell-Hedges writes: "... the population to have been five hundred thousand in this city alone. Imagine five hundred thousand people in one great city, and ... I believe there were over one hundred (cities) ... in Central America, evidences have been definite that everywhere was densely populated, a mighty civilization."

Bancroft Quoted

Bancroft Quoted




- Behold, their women did toil and spin, and did make all manner of cloth, of fine twined linen, and cloth of every kind, ...

- The Jones Store advertised its “First Lady” bed sheets with 140 threads to the inch as the best in Kansas City.


Since that time finer weaves have been made but none to match those of ancient America for tombs in Peru have yielded textiles with 300 threads to the inch.

- ❑ Weave is exceptionally fine

- ❑ Book of Mormon predicted such cloth would be found




Mosiah 7:11-13

- ❑ Inlaid stone




- ❑ House of the Governor at Uxmal
- ❑ One of a number of buildings at Uxmal
- ❑ Fine craftsmanship in stone construction
- ❑ Thousands of cubic feet of masonry



- El Tajin
 - Eastern Mexico near Vera Cruz
- Use of pyramid ... unknown
- Evidence of building ability

- ❑ Pyramid of the Sun
- ❑ Teotihuacan near Mexico City
- ❑ 628 feet by 638 feet at the base
- ❑ 208 feet high
- ❑ What the pyramid was called by its builders is unknown
- ❑ Superb craftsmanship



Jarom 1:19

- ❑ “And we multiplied exceedingly, and spread upon the face of the land, and became exceeding rich in ... machinery ...”
- ❑ Chariots and machinery are mentioned in the Book of Mormon
- ❑ Use wheels and axles

❑ Wheeled Toy

– from mural in the National Palace in Mexico City

- ❑ Book of Mormon ridiculed for its statement on machinery
- ❑ Discoveries show that such knowledge was known among ancient peoples of the time.



3 Nephi 3: 8

- “And it came to pass that there were many cities built anew, and there were many old cities repaired, and there were many highways cast up, and many roads made, which led from city to city, and from land to land, and from place to place.”

Roads

- “The roads ... are as good as the best procured by modern engineering. There are composed of stone slabs set in a concrete bed and today, with some repairs would be perfectly serviceable.”


Roads


September 7, 1930



- ❑ Temptation of Eve
- ❑ Taken from the *Codex Vaticanus*
 - ancient Aztec book
- ❑ Tells of Temptation of Eve and of Cain and Abel
- ❑ Note the two altars
 - One turned down
 - » Rejection of sacrifice
 - The other upright
 - » Acceptance of sacrifice

Bancroft

- “Votan ... is said to have been a descendant of Noah and to have assisted at the building of the Tower of Babel. After the confusion of tongues he led a portion of the dispersed people to America.”

Descendants from Tower of Babel

- Book of Mormon
 - Jaredites
- Complete agreement with
 - Bancroft
 - Biblical accounts
 - » people dispersed upon all the face of the earth

Ezekiel 37:16

- “Moreover, thou son of man, take thee one stick, and write upon it, For Judah, and for the children of Israel his companions; then take another stick, and write upon it, For Joseph, the stick of Ephraim, and for all the house of Israel his companions.”

Sticks

- 'Stick' means book
 - Books written on scrolls and carried around on sticks in the days of Ezekiel
- One stick for Judah
- One stick for Joseph
 - Descendants of Joseph
 - Went over the wall (sea) Genesis 29:22
- Book of Mormon = Stick of Joseph

Ezekiel 37:17

- “And join them one to another into one stick; and they shall become one in thine hand.”
- Form a unified witness

Jeremiah 49:30, 31

- “Flee, get you far off, dwell deep, o ye inhabitants of Hazor, saith the Lord; for Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon hath taken counsel against you, and hath conceived a purpose against you.

Arise, get you up unto the wealthy nation, that dwelleth without care, saith the Lord, which have neither gates nor bars, which dwell alone.”

Jeremiah's Prophecy

- ❑ Given between 700 and 600 B.C.
- ❑ Land without gates nor bars
 - Americas
 - No known cities in the world at that time fit his description
- ❑ Lehi, around 600 B.C.
 - Took his family and started a journey to this land
 - Genesis 49:22

Brinton

- “Hardly a nation on the continent but seems to have had some vague tradition of an origin from four brothers, to have at some time been led by four brothers or princes ...”

Myths of the New World, page 101

- Lehi had four sons
 - progenitors of the nations on this continent.

Baldwin

- “He (Montsinor) gives the Peruvian nation a beginning which is, at least, not incredible. It was originated, he says, by a people led by four brothers who settled in the valley of Cusco, and developed civilization there in a very human way. The youngest of these brothers assumed supreme authority, and became the first of a long line of sovereigns.

 - Book of Mormon


