

 - serve Him through His church




- Jesus Christ

- Church of Jesus Christ, restored again on the earth in 1830
- The message of Jesus Christ is central to our lives



□ Isaiah 9: 6, 7

For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given' and the government shall be upon his shoulder' and his name shall be called Wonderful, Counsellor, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace. - Luke 2:6, 7




- An Angel and the Shepherds
- Luke 2:8-14
- Angels minister for the Lord



- ❑ Shepherds visit Christ
- ❑ Luke 2: 15, 16
- ❑ The shepherds went forth telling everyone the glad tidings of Christ's birth



- ❑ Christ Presented at the Temple
- ❑ Luke 2:22-34
- ❑ Jesus was 40 days old
- ❑ He was not baptized or christened
- ❑ Christ was blessed at the temple




- ❑ Wise Men Follow the Star
- ❑ Mathew 2:1, 2
- ❑ Divine revelation to the wise men



- ❑ Wise Men Inquire for the Babe
- ❑ Matthew 2:1, 2
- ❑ Directed to Herod
 - Roman king, ruler of Jerusalem and the nearby lands



- ❑ Wise Men Before Herod
- ❑ Matthew 2:4-8
- ❑ Chief priests and scribes knew that the Messiah was to be born in Bethlehem
- ❑ Chief priests
 - Rulers of the church
- ❑ Scribes
 - Those knowledgeable in the Scriptures



- ❑ Wise Men Offer Gifts
- ❑ Matthew 2:11, 12
- ❑ God warned the wise men in a dream
 - King Herod wanted to kill the babe
 - Directed them to return home a different way
 - Not to return to Herod

- ❑ Joseph warned to flee to Egypt
- ❑ Matthew 2:13
- ❑ Angel of the Lord
 - appeared unto Joseph
 - warned him to flee





- ❑ Flight into Egypt
- ❑ Matthew 2: 14, 15
- ❑ Long, tedious journey
- ❑ Made because Joseph and Mary obeyed God's commands
- ❑ Herod sent out a decree
 - All newborn males less than 2 years old were to be killed
 - Herod's own son may have been slain
- ❑ Man cannot thwart God's plan


□ **Joseph told that Herod had died**

– Herod had died






- ❑ Mary and Jesus at the well
- ❑ Luke 2:40
- ❑ Jesus grows up
- ❑ Assumes responsibility, just like other children
- ❑ No record of His childhood

□ Jesus among the Doctors


□ Luke 2:41-49

- Twelve years old
- About his Father's business
- Speaking intelligently with learned religious leaders of the day






- ❑ Jesus at home, in Nazareth
- ❑ Luke 2:43
- ❑ Jesus was subject to His parents
- ❑ Helped them earn their livelihood
- ❑ He grew to adulthood in this home environment



- John the Baptist preaches and baptizes
- Matthew 3:1-6
- Preparing the way for Jesus
 - Preaching repentance
 - Baptizing by water
 - Acknowledges the limitation of his baptism
- Jesus baptizes by water and the Spirit
 - Matthew 3:11
 - John 1:26-30

- ❑ Jesus baptized by John the Baptist
- ❑ Matthew 3:13-17
- ❑ Immersion
- ❑ Fulfilling all righteousness
- ❑ Mark 1:8-11
 - Holy Ghost descends
 - "This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased."






- ❑ In the Wilderness
- ❑ Matthew 4:1
- ❑ Fasting
- ❑ Prayer
- ❑ Being with God
- ❑ 40 days and 40 nights



- The Temptation
- Matthew 4:8-10
- Tempted of Satan
- Response to temptation
 - "It is written ..."



- Behold, the Lamb of God
- John 1:35, 36
- John the Baptist bears witness of the Son of God



- ❑ Jesus, with Andrew, Simon Peter, and John
- ❑ John 1:37-42
- ❑ After being tempted, Jesus immediately begins His ministry
- ❑ Talked with these men about the truths of the kingdom



- Departure into Galilee
- John 1:43-46
- Soon after, more were added as disciples
 - Andrew
 - Peter
 - Phillip
 - Nathaniel
 - Others




- Jesus teaches his disciples on the Mount
- Matthew 5, 6, and 7
- Message that Jesus wanted His disciples to teach others



- ❑ Jesus Proclaims His Messiahship
- ❑ Luke 4:18, 19
- ❑ In Nazareth
- ❑ At the synagogue
- ❑ Read from Isaiah
- ❑ He was rejected from his home town
 - Luke 4:28, 29



- ❑ Marriage at Cana
- ❑ John 2:1-11
- ❑ Jesus attended with His mother
- ❑ Marriage is blessed by God
 - Mark 10:6, 9



- ❑ Peter confesses Christ
- ❑ Matthew 16:13-16



- ❑ Blessed art thou ...
- ❑ Matthew 16:17, 18
- ❑ The “rock”
 - Revelation of the fact that Jesus is the Christ
- ❑ Christ directs His church through revelation
- ❑ Peter had no special dispensation in this regard
- ❑ Christ teaches the disciples about revelation through this event






Galatians 1:11, 12

- But I certify you, brethren, that the gospel which was preached of me is not after man. For I neither received it of man, neither was I taught it, but by the revelation of Jesus Christ.

ROCK OF REVELATION

Ephesians 2:19, 20

- Now therefore ye are no more strangers and foreigners, but fellow-citizens with the saints, and of the household of God; and are built upon the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Jesus Christ himself being the chief corner stone.

□ Cornerstone functions to

– square the building

□ Foundation

– Apostles

– Prophets

□ Saints

– not perfect people

– are baptized believers



ROCK OF REVELATION

Ephesians 4:11-13

- And he gave some, apostles; and some, prophets; and some, evangelists; and some pastors and teachers; for the perfecting of the saints, for the work of the ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ; Till we all come in the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, unto a perfect man, unto the measure of the stature of the fulness of Christ.




- ❑ The Rich Young Ruler

- How apostles are 'called'




- The Call of the Twelve and Seventy

ROCK OF REVELATION


Matthew 7:29 & Mark 1:22

- ❑ For he taught them as one having authority, and not as the scribes.
- ❑ And they were astonished at his doctrine; for he taught them as one that had authority, and not as the scribes.
- ❑ Christ's message came from God, as did His authority to minister.

Hebrews 6:1, 2

- Repentance from dead works
- Faith toward God
- Baptisms
- Laying on of hands
- Resurrection of the dead
- Eternal Judgment

- ❑ Christ walks on the water
- ❑ Matthew 14:25-27






- ❑ Peter Sinks
- ❑ Matthew 14:28-33
- ❑ Peter walks on the water
 - by faith in Jesus Christ
- ❑ Peter sinks
 - when his faith wavered



- ❑ Healing the Woman
- ❑ Mark 5:25-34
- ❑ Faith must be present for healing to occur
- ❑ Christ emphasized the need for faith
- ❑ Faith for healing of
 - physical body
 - soul


- ❑ Return of the Prodigal
- ❑ Luke 15:11-24
- ❑ Need for Christ changes a person's
 - heart
 - attitude
 - way of life
- ❑ Repentance





- ❑ Zaccheus the Publican
- ❑ Luke 19:2-8
- ❑ Publican
 - tax collector for the Roman government
 - Considered a traitor to his own people
- ❑ Interested in himself
- ❑ Getting what he wanted
 - at the expense of others
- ❑ Compared with Christ
 - Zaccheus saw himself as he really was
- ❑ Repented
- ❑ Repaid fourfold

ROCK OF REVELATION



- Jesus with Nicodemus
- John 3:1-5
- Baptism
 - not an option
 - required
- Matthew 3:15
- John 3:5
- Mark 16:16
- Baptism
 - an ordinance
 - a covenant relationship
 - forsake evil
 - take name of Christ
 - by immersion




- Baptism of Christ
- Matthew 3:13-15
- Demonstrated
 - humility
 - symbolic of covenant
 - under authority of Father




- ❑ Christ Baptized by the Spirit
- ❑ Matthew 3:16, 17
- ❑ Followed baptism by water
- ❑ Then performed by laying on of hands
- ❑ Paul at Ephesus
 - Acts 19:1-6
- ❑ Baptism must be by a minister having authority
- ❑ Baptism of the Spirit completes the ordinance of baptism

- Baptism of the Water and Spirit
- Only door to
 - a proper relationship with God



ROCK OF REVELATION



- ❑ Ananias heals Saul of blindness
- ❑ Acts 9:17, 18
- ❑ A function of laying on of hands
- ❑ Ananias, a servant of God
 - Not an apostle




- ❑ Jesus heals the sick
- ❑ Luke 4:40
- ❑ Laying on of hands
- ❑ James 5:14-16



- ❑ Jesus blesses little children
- ❑ Mark 10:14-16
- ❑ Matthew 19:14, 15
- ❑ Another example of laying on of hands

- The Church
- Laying on of hands
 - A scriptural function
 - Performed by Elders
 - » authoritatively called of God



ROCK OF REVELATION




- ❑ Resurrection of Jesus
- ❑ John 20:1-9, 19, 20, 27-29
- ❑ As Jesus arose from the dead, so shall we
- ❑ Two general resurrections:
 - Resurrection of the Just
 - » Revelation 20:4,5
 - Rest of the dead
 - » Following one thousand years
 - » Revelation 20:5
- ❑ Further presentation to come on this topic

- ❑ Separating the Sheep from the Goats
- ❑ Matthew 25:31-33
- ❑ Man has been given agency to choose
- ❑ God will judge according to those choices
 - Revelation 20:12, 13
 - 2 Corinthians 5:10

ROCK OF REVELATION

1 Thessalonians 1:5

- “For our gospel came not unto you in word only, but also in power, and in the Holy Ghost, and in much assurance.”
- Power from on High
 - distinguishes the Christian movement

1 Corinthians 12:8-10

- “These signs shall follow them that believe.”
- Various manifestations of the Spirit
- Yet, it is the same Spirit
- Expression of the Spirit
 - uplifting believers
 - edifying believers


Acts 2:17




ROCK OF REVELATION

ROCK OF REVELATION




- ❑ Jesus, the Good Shepherd
- ❑ John 10:1-16
- ❑ The good shepherd loves his sheep and cares for them
 - Christ is the Good Shepherd
- ❑ Christ asks:
 - Love Him
 - Love one another
 - » be willing to lay down our lives for one another
- ❑ Church established as evidence of His love for us.

Matthew 22:37-39

- Love is the final test for a Christian
- Would you lay down your life for your friends?
 - John 15:13
- Love your enemies
 - Matthew 5:44-46

- ❑ Christ is the hope of the world
- ❑ Breaking down the barriers mankind has erected
- ❑ Tools
 - Gospel
 - His Spirit

- ❑ The Parable of the House on the Rock
- ❑ Matthew 7:25-27
- ❑ Cannot just hear the Word of God
- ❑ Build a firm foundation
 - Accept Christ
 - Keep His commandments





- ❑ I stand at the door and knock
- ❑ Revelation 3:20
- ❑ Christ stands at the door of your heart
 - Knocking
 - Asking to come in
- ❑ How will you respond?
